The words to this song are found in The Salvation Army Song Book (*number 324*) and they express much of the mission and vision of The Salvation Army.. Julia Roper, Songster Leader at Ringwood Corps and MSS Deputy, has provided a contemporary setting which is quite accessible.

A confident Alto soloist will be required for the opening verse.
A broad dynamic range from the singers will enhance the presentation of this song. While there are moments that require strong, tutti ensemble sound there are also moments in the music needing equally strong independence from individual sections of the choir.

It will be beneficial to understand the overall shape of the song and allow the music to gradually and gently dissipate after the climax.
