Originally written as the Witnesses For Christ (2007-2008) Sessional Song; the lyric of the chorus is based on the text found in Isaiah 43:10.

"You are my witnesses," declares the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, so that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he." (NIV)

The song challenges us to take a stand and be recognised as witnesses for Christ. Yet at the same time there is a security in knowing that we are called and chosen to be God's people in the world.

The opening phrase, and repetitions of the phrase, need to be sung with confidence and an amount of strength and power (this is after all Gods declaration).

Though the verses are written as unison passages there is opportunity to use soloists or a small group from the choir.
