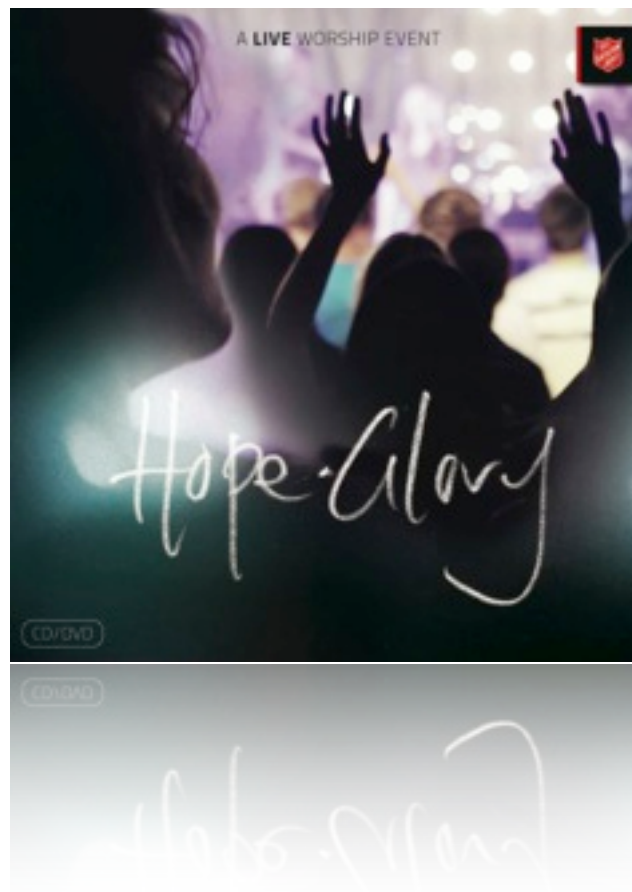

INTRODUCTION

“Some people trust in chariots.” What? Trusting in chariots is a biblical metaphor for putting confidence in what man can do. When Jesus comes on the scene in the New Testament, He shows a different kind of power that is wrapped in weakness. When we look at Jesus’ life, the way He showed power was to keep close to the Father and do absolutely nothing outside of what He saw His Father doing. From the manger where He was born to the cross where He died, He placed Himself completely in God’s hands and showed us the power in being weak. For when we are weak, we are really strong in Him.
