

OPAL TOP UP MACHINE and TYPES OF OPAL CARDS



Top up machine – to top up your Opal card yourself using cash or credit card

Child/youth Opal - Children aged 3 years and under travel free on public transport in NSW. Children aged 4 – 15 years are entitled to concession fares. Eligible secondary students aged 16 years and older also pay concession fares with their proof of entitlement card.

Primary and secondary students Opal - May also be entitled to free or subsidised travel to and from school.

Concession Opal– for eligible tertiary students, trainees, apprentices, job seekers or other approved Centrelink customers

Adult - for customers 16 years of age and over who normally pay full fares

Gold Opal – if you have NSW Seniors Card, Pensioner Concession Card, NSW War Widow/ers Card, or an eligible interstate senior or asylum seeker.

Free Opal – if you are a veteran or a visually impaired person, you are eligible for this card.
