COURSE DESCRIPTION

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

Two specialisations are completed for the award of this qualification - Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Home and Community). To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the units of competency. No licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

ENROLLING IN FIRST AID UNITS OF COMPETENCY

If you are seeking to enrol in a First Aid unit of competency you are advised that to complete the unit you must be able to perform basic life support skills, for example control bleeding and perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). If you have a disability that would prevent you from performing required basic life support skills you are advised that you will not be able to achieve the unit of competency.

Work Placement: This course has a compulsory work placement 120 hours. Work placement will start in week 5 approximately one day a week in addition you will be required to do a two week block placement (Monday to Friday) in week 17 of each semester. This will be the weeks beginning 4/06/2018 until 15/06/2018. You will be required to apply for National Police Check and complete the NSW Health Vaccination/ Immunisation card. Please note that this needs to be completed prior to attending placement. You will also be required to do additional units online throughout your enrolment to complete the course. You will also be required to purchase a polo shirt to be worn on your work placement.
