



Dialogue – Making a withdrawal at a bank

You need to withdraw some money. So you come to your local bank to take some money out.

- Hassan Hi, I'd like to withdraw some money, please.
- Teller Sure. Do you have your ATM card with you?
- Hassan Yes, I do.
- Teller Could you please swipe your card?
- Hassan Okay (*swiping the card onto the machine in front of him*)
- Teller How much are you taking out?
- Hassan Can I have \$ 350 please?
- Teller Sure! Can you swipe your card again please? And key in your PIN number
- Hassan Okay (*swiping the card and key in PIN number*)
- Teller (*count the money and hand it over to you*). Here we go, one hundred, two hundred, three hundred, and fifty (*counting the money again in front of you while giving it to you...*) All done (*giving the receipt to you*). Anything else I can help you with today?
- Hassan That's all thank you.
- Teller Do you know that you can take up to \$1000 using the ATM? Next time you can just go to your nearest ATM and you do not need to come to the bank.
- Hassan Oh, okay. So, I don't need to come to the bank if I don't need more than \$ 1000?
- Teller No, that's right. You can just make a withdrawal from the ATM. I do suggest however, do not take too much money at one time for your safety.
