

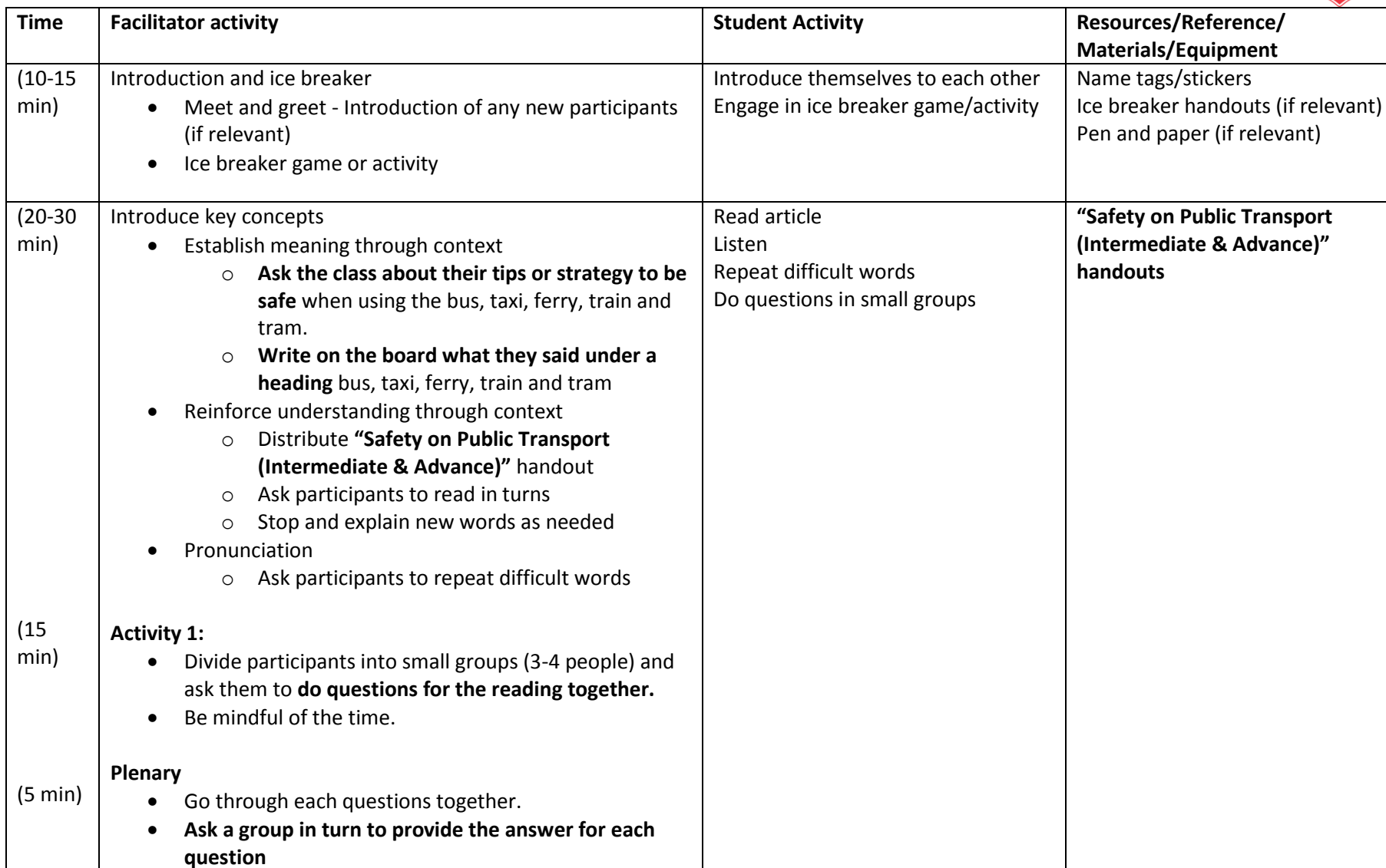


Lesson Plan

Duration: 2 hours

<p>No. of participants:</p> <p>Level: Intermediate and Advance</p> <p>Topic: Introducing safety measures when using public transport</p>	
<p>Lesson aims: By the end of the lesson, participants should know how to keep safe in public transport</p>	
<p>Specific learning outcomes:</p> <p>By the end of the lesson, participants should be able to understand key vocabularies and concepts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Police and Protective Services Officers (PSOs)• CCTV• Emergency assistance buttons• Safety Zone• Online rides• Apps (Applications)	<p>Assessment methods:</p> <p>Teacher to listen to participants' pronunciation and check understanding on key vocabularies</p>
<p>Previous knowledge assumed: intermediate to advance</p>	
<p>Materials and equipment required: Whiteboard, markers, "Safety on Public Transport (Intermediate & Advance)" handout</p>	
<p>Room layout: O shape</p>	
<p>General notes on differentiation / learning styles: facilitating techniques involve auditory, visual and kinaesthetic methods.</p>	
<p>Anticipated problems and solutions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Some participants may have difficulty understanding and pronouncing new vocabularies such as "threatened", "assertively", and "surveillance".<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Use many visual aids, descriptions, gestures and synonyms to explain through context.○ Model and drill pronunciation several times.	





	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Discuss and invite other groups to contribute if the initial group has difficulty answering the question.

Do you normally feel safe when travelling on a public transport? Please explain.5. Would you rather use public transport or private vehicle? Why?6. Have you ever had to go home at night on a public transport? Share your experience. What did you do to stay safe?7. Have you or someone you know experienced feeling threatened by another passenger on a public transport? Please share your experience (if you feel comfortable).8. Have you or someone you know had a bad experience travelling on a Taxi? Please share your experience (if you feel comfortable).	Discuss in small groups	N/A
