### EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN

**Long day care**

A child can attend when s(he) turns 5 years old by 30<sup>th</sup> April.

**Prep**

A state-wide exam for year 12 students that influence university entry

**Kindergarten**

Schools that are run by private organisations and charge school fees.

**Primary school**

A specialised education support to learners who do not speak Standard Australian English as their first language in VIC State schools

**Secondary school**

Pre-school education for 3 and 4 years old and is subsidised by the government

**Victoria Certificate of Education (VCE)**

A form of child care that is available for 8 hours or more during the day when parents are working. e

**English as an Additional Language (EAL)**

Schools that are funded by the government and do not charge school fees apart from books, uniforms and extra-curricular subjects /activities.

**Public school**

The first 6 years of schooling - Grade 1 to 6

**Independent school**

The continuation of primary school - Grade 7 to 12



## EDUCATION FOR ADULTS

### **Postgraduate course**

Free English language class for adult from the government

### **AMEP**

On-the-job training you can do while studying at TAFE

### **Apprenticeship**

Next level of study after completing a Bachelor degree

### **HECS-HELP**

An option of study where you can study 2 or 3 days/week only

### **TAFE**

A place where you can study for a Bachelor or Master degree.

### **Undergraduate course**

A degree awarded to you after you complete a post graduate study

### **University**

Usually offer vocational courses with apprenticeship opportunities

### **Master degree**

Usually your first study at a University and you will get a Bachelor degree

### **Part time**

Financial assistance in form of study loan from the government to pay for tertiary

### **Commonwealth Supported Place**

Offers specialised tertiary study, can be privately owned and faith-based

### **College**

Subsidy from the government to pay part of your university/TAFE fees
