

SAFETY MEASURES AT HOME



Fire Blanket & Smoke Alarm

- Fire blanket is to put out small fire. Eg. oil or fat fires on stove. Do NOT attempt to put out big fire.
- Install an adequate number of smoke alarms and test them regularly.



Door Lock & Keys

- Always lock your doors
- Put keys in safe place not in obvious place eg. doormats
- Make sure every window/door can be quickly opened (in case of fire)



Sales/trades Persons

- Ask for identification before letting them in
- If you are unsure, call the person's office before letting him/her in.



Neighbours

- Get to know your neighbours.
- Exchange telephone numbers.
- Keep an eye on each other's homes.



Emergency Number

- 000 is the number to call for Police, Fire and Ambulance.
- If you have escaped from a home fire, remember once you get out stay out and dial Triple Zero (000).

RISKS



Valuables

- Do not put your valuables in obvious place
- Mark valuables with engraver, ultra violet pen to make it harder to sell by thieves



Gas Leak

Fire risk! Get out from the house, turn off main meter if possible or call 000



Cooking

- Do not leave stove unattended
- Never throw water onto oil fire. Use fire blanket if it is safe to do so. If not, call 000



Electric Blankets

Always switch off before going to bed or leaving the house



Heaters

- Keep burnable items well away from heaters
- Switch off when leaving the house
- Do not leave it on all night



Power Points

Do **NOT** overload power points
