

Auslan Interpreter & Service Fees

What is Auslan?

Auslan is the language of the Australian Deaf Community. Auslan is a word made up by combining the words Australian Sign Language.

Why is Auslan Interpretation necessary?

- The Deaf Community of Australia acquire Australian sign language (Auslan) as their primary means of communication rather than spoken or written English.
- Being a person from the Deaf Community differs from a person who is hard of hearing whose auditory ability is enhanced with a hearing aid.
- Access to professional interpreting and translation services is essential for the Deaf Community to understand information, make independent decisions and engage with and be included in Salvation Army activities.
- A deaf person's abilities in fluency of written English and reading proficiency (including captions) vary, should not be assumed, and should always be checked with every individual.

Types of Interpreting & Translation for the Deaf Community

- Credentialed interpreters and translators in Auslan are certified by NAATI (National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters).
- Deaf interpreters are trained and certified users of Auslan who are able to convey meaning from Auslan to a highly visual form of gesture. Deaf interpreters usually work in conjunction with an Auslan interpreter.
- Note takers translate verbal communication into written English in real time.

What situations should an Interpreter be engaged?

- In every expression of the Salvation Army (whether internal organisational operations or external missional engagement) where a conversation takes place with a person from the Deaf Community who communicates using Auslan.
- External Salvation Army communications conveying information to the public.
- At meetings, conferences, workshops, (in-person or online via video) where people from the Deaf Community who communicate using Auslan are present.
