LEGO® Prayer Activities

LEGO is amazing!

With a little bit of imagination, a few bricks can be transformed into wonderful creations for people to enjoy. A single LEGO brick on its own isn't very useful until others are joined with it to make something unique.

After LEGO bricks are put together to create something new, they are united and are far more noticeable than just a bunch of bricks sitting in a box. We are reminded in the Bible that when Jesus' followers come together, other people noticed them. Imagine if Jesus' followers were like LEGO bricks? On their own they can't do a lot, but when they are united, they can become amazing creations that are noticed by others. As followers of Jesus, we can share God's love to others even more when we work together.

LEGO prayer activities to remind us how we can work together with other followers of Jesus:

-  Work with a friend or family member to transform a selection of LEGO bricks into something useful like a pen organiser, tissue box cover, pot plant holder or something else around your house. Thank God for the people who help you become more like Jesus (they might be members of your family or leaders/friends at church).
-  Choose a LEGO brick with eight studs (either a 2x4 or 1x8 brick). Add eight more bricks by placing one on each stud. As you place each brick, pray for a friend or family member who helps you learn more about Jesus.
-  Create a LEGO scene that shows people working together, or one that tells a story about how much God loves you. Share your creations with others so they can find out how much God loves them too.

If you don't have access to LEGO or similar bricks, see if your local toy library has some for you to borrow.
