

Intergenerational segment

Read or watch I'm Australian Too by Mem Fox.

- Place a large map of the world on a wall (a simple sketch of the continents will be fine for this activity). Alternatively, place a large sheet of paper in the middle of each table and ask those at the table to sketch their own world map.
- Provide markers or dot stickers and invite everyone to come and place marks on the map to indicate where their family comes from. Allow people to place as many marks as they would like to. Acknowledge that sometimes we don't know where our families have come from.
- In small groups, discuss these questions – make sure everyone has an opportunity to speak:

Why do you think Australia is a great place to live?

What makes someone Australian?

How could you welcome someone who is new to Australia?
