4. StorySheets

Each episode comes with a printable StorySheet which retells the story. Kids can colour them in and write down their answers if they like. One way to use the StorySheets is as a recap straight after the video. Sometimes hearing the story twice before answering can be really effective. Another way to use the StorySheets is as a take home reminder.



5. Extra

Make sure to always let parents know if there is Bible content in your program. Some parents can be sensitive about such things, so it's worth putting it in your advertising or sending a note home. For instance one Kids Club program has a Muslim family attend, so when it's Bible Story time the parents have asked that they could sit outside until the lesson is over. We want all kids to know Jesus, but we have to be respectful of parents wishes.

6. Use it Anywhere

Kids Bible Vids is made for outreach programs like 'Kids in the Kitchen', 'JustBrass', Kids Clubs etc. But it can also be used in church, Sunday Schools and even one on one, a grandparent and their grandchildren, a family after dinnertime or a motivated kid with their friends.
