5. If you had been there that day and heard Jesus say, 'Before Abraham was, I AM,' what would have been going through your mind?

6. The incarnation means the Son emptied himself of glory to take on human nature-. When you think of God's reasons for doing that, which reasons do you think of? How does it make you feel?

7. Why do you think it is so valuable for us that Jesus has 'two natures', divine and human?

8. How does it make you feel to think that the Son of God became human just like you?
