Home alone

- In Australia, when someone under age 18 (including siblings) cares for younger children, parents may be held responsible if something goes wrong
- No actual law stating age when children can be left alone.



Parenting and Child Discipline

- In Australia, beating children is against the law.
- Someone may report you to the Police or Child Protection if you beat children.
