

Step by Step Guide to Use an ATM to Make a Withdrawal

1. Find an ATM (Automated Teller Machine)



Find an ATM from your bank. You may be charged a fee if you withdraw from an ATM not from your bank.

2. Insert your ATM card.



Put your card into the **slot** on the right hand of the machine




Is your card in the **right direction**? It will not work if the direction is wrong.

3. Enter your PIN (Personal Identification Number)




Your PIN is a **four digit number**. **Cover numbers** with your other hands for **safety**.



After pressing your PIN, press **Enter**




4. Select Withdrawal option on the screen




Press **Withdrawal**

5. Select the account you will withdraw from – normally Savings




Press **Savings**

6. Select Display or Print Balance



Display Balance – your account balance will be shown on the screen only.
Print Balance – your will get your balance on a **receipt**

7. Select the amount of money you want to take




You can press the amount on the **screen**: \$20, \$50, \$100, \$200 OR
 You can press the amount on **key pad**. For example: \$40 or \$250 – ATMs only accepts multiples of \$20 or \$50
 Then press **Enter**

8. Take your ATM card



Take your card back from the slot



You can see your **balance on the screen**

9. Take your money



10. Take your receipt (if you chose this option earlier)
