

## SAFETY MEASURES AT HOME



### Fire Blanket & Smoke Alarm

- Fire blanket is to put out small fire. Eg. stove, candles. Do NOT attempt to put out big fire.
- Install an adequate number of smoke alarms and test them regularly.



### Door Lock & Keys

- Always lock your doors
- Make sure every window/door can be quickly opened (in case of fire).



### Sales Persons

- Ask for identification from all sales persons who request to come in.
- If you are unsure, call the person's office before letting him/her in.



### Neighbours

- Get to know your neighbours.
- Exchange telephone numbers.
- Keep an eye on each other's homes.



### Emergency Number

- 000 is the number to call for Police, Fire and Ambulance.
- If you have escaped from a home fire, remember once you get out stay out and dial Triple Zero (000).

## RISKS



### VALUABLES

Do not put your valuables on easy to see or reach location.



### GAS LEAK

Fire risk! Get out from the house, turn off main meter if possible or call 000



### STOVE

Do not leave stove unattended when cooking. Use fire blanket if it is safe to do so. If not, call 000



### CANDLE

Do not light candle near flammable things such as curtains and papers



### HEATER

Do not cover heater with clothes etc. Do not leave it on all night.



### POWERPOINTS

Do NOT overload power points
