Home alone

- There is no one law in Australia that says how old children must be before you can leave them home alone.
- Even if your child is OK to be home alone, you are still responsible for their safety.

Parenting and Child Discipline

- Parenting and raising children in a new country with different culture can be challenging.
- Australia law says parents have the right to discipline children but must not hurt children through discipline such as “smacking”.
