### **Student A – Centrelink officer**

- Give Tin \$ 500

### **Student B – Tin**

- Receives \$500 from Centrelink

### **Student C – Western Union teller**

- Tin to give \$100 to the teller, who then gives the money to student D.

### **Student D – mother in Burma**

- Receives \$ 100

### **Student E – supermarket cashier**

- Tin to give \$150 to the cashier.

### **Student F – mobile phone salesman**

- Tin to give \$50 to the salesman

### **Student G – SmartRider card seller**

- Tin to give \$50 to the seller

### **Student F – real estate agent**

- Tin does not have \$ 300 for rent payment
