


## Types of Tickets

<b>Cash</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Can be purchased from ticket machines at train stations, ferry jetties, and from bus drivers.</li> <li>Allows travels within a certain distance within a time limit, on any combination of bus, train or ferry services.</li> <li>Cost of travels to more than two zones will be capped at the cost of a two-zone fare.</li> </ul>
<b>SmartRider</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><u>The cheapest and most convenient way</u> to ride on all Transperth services.</li> <li>The card fits into a wallet and can be topped-up with additional funds as needed.</li> </ul> <p><u>SmartRider Benefits</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>20% discount off fares if you recharge with Autoload</li> <li>Can be used to pay for parking at Transperth train station</li> <li>Online registration for security if it is lost or stolen</li> <li>Easy/quick online transaction history and card balance check.</li> </ul>
<b>Special</b>	<p><b>Two-section fare</b> – a one-way ride on a single bus, train or ferry service for a trip of 3.2 km or less.</p> <p><b>DayRider</b> – for unlimited all day travel.</p> <p><b>FamilyRider</b> – for unlimited all day travel for a group of up to 7 people where no more than 2 people pay full fare.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This ticket can only be purchased at certain times such as weekends and public holidays.</li> </ul>

## Types of SmartRider Cards

<b>Standard</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For those without a Concession card</li> <li>Provides 10% discount off the full (cash) fare.</li> <li>Can be purchased at Transperth InfoCentres or Retail Sales Outlets.</li> </ul>
<b>Concession</b> <b>Carer/Aged/Disability</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For holders of valid concession cards that are not covered by other types of SmartRider card ie. Health care, DHS &amp; Veteran Affairs</li> <li>Only one concession card can be registered as Concession SmartRider – the latest card registered</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any older concession cards will revert to a Standard SmartRider.</li> <li>Apply at a Transperth InfoCentres or Retail Sales Outlet.</li> </ul>
<b>Seniors</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For those who hold Western Australia Seniors card</li> <li>A double-sided card – one side a Seniors SmartRiders, the other a WA Seniors card.</li> <li>Apply in person at the WA Seniors Card or by mail after completing an application form.</li> <li>Application form is available from most bank or download from <a href="http://www.seniorcard.wa.gov.au">www.seniorcard.wa.gov.au</a></li> </ul>
<b>Pensioner</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For holders of Carer, Aged Pension or Disability Support Pension.</li> <li>There is no need to apply for a Pensioner SmartRider if you hold a WA Seniors card</li> <li>Apply in person at a Transperth InfoCentre or Retail Sales Outlet or call 136213 to have an application form sent to you in the post.</li> </ul>
<b>Veterans</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Veterans or a Dependent Partner, War Widow or Widower who do not receive Income Support Supplement, or those who receive Disability Pension (70-100%)</li> </ul>
<b>Student</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For primary and secondary school students</li> <li>The card can be ordered online through Monitor WA website for participating schools.</li> <li>For non-participating schools, students need to download an application form from Transperth website, have it authorised by school administration and mail it to the address shown on the form.</li> </ul>
<b>Tertiary</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For full-time students at WA University or TAFE, secondary students attending school in the year they are turning 19 years old or older, interstate primary or secondary students.</li> <li>Student IDs are not accepted as proof of full-time tertiary students. Students must apply for Tertiary SmartRider to claim its benefits.</li> <li>Find information on obtaining and activating Tertiary SmartRider on Transperth website or from the education institutions.</li> </ul>



<b>Asylum Seeker – ASH Concession</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For people seeking asylum residing in WA and not in full-time education or employment.</li><li>• Application form is available from Association for Services to Torture and Trauma Survivors (ASeTTS), Centre for Asylum Seekers, Refugees and Detainees (CARAD), Australian Red Cross, Circle Green, Riverview Community Services, Welcome to Australia or Mercycare.</li><li>• After completing the application form, you can submit at the Elizabeth Quay Bus Station InfoCentre.</li></ul>
