



Definitions:

Ambulance Service - is used to treat urgent medical conditions, and for the transportation of ill or injured people to, from or between places of treatment for an illness or injury.

Breaking into – Illegally accessing by causing damage.

Dangerous - involving possible injury, pain, harm, or loss

Emergency Services – professionals trained to respond to urgent, dangerous or life threatening events.

Fire Service: the people whose job it is to put out fires and rescue people

Incident – what has taken place, or the event

Location - a place or position or address of where you are, or where the incident happened is the location.

Police – the people whose job is to enforce laws, investigate crimes, and make arrests.

Safe place – somewhere out of danger or harm's way.

Service - work performed in an expert manner by an individual or team for the benefit of its customers. For example: intangible products, such as accounting, banking, consulting, cleaning, landscaping, education, insurance, treatment, and transportation services.

Threaten - to be something that is likely to cause harm to (someone or something): to be a threat to (someone or something)

Urgent - requiring immediate action or attention
