

SAFETY IN PUBLIC SETTINGS



BE CAREFUL - MONEY

Do **NOT** withdraw a lot of money from ATM or at night.




BE SAFE AT NIGHT

- Do **NOT** walk alone at night
- **Tell someone** where you are going and when you will return.
- Walk on **busy or bright** street



CAR SAFE

Do **NOT** leave your bag, phone, laptops and other valuables in the car



ROAD SAFE

- Cross at **pedestrian crossing** or crossing light, wait for the '**green**' man.
- **Hold children's hands** when crossing

SAFETY IN PUBLIC TRANSPORT




TRAIN

- Stay **behind the yellow line**
- Always stay off train tracks
- Stay in well-lit areas in view of security cameras
- Be aware of the location of emergency button



BUS

- Wait in **bright area** or near **other people**
- **Sit near the driver**
- **After 7pm** when it is safe for the driver to stop, they will drop you off closer to your destination.



Edge

FERRY

- **Stand back** from **wharf edge**
- **Inform ferry staff** for emergency
- **At night:**
 - **Check time and connection** to avoid delay
 - **Sit near ferry staff**



TAXI

- **Calling** (from a safe place) rather than hailing from street
- **Tell the route** and be **assertive**
- Take **driver's & company's name**, and **car number**
