## Intergenerational segment

*Copy and print enough A4 copies of the clock template (see page 2) for each person OR create a large copy and ask everyone to contribute. You will need pencils or markers.*

On the clock, in each circle, write or draw something that makes a home safe and comfortable. For example, heater/fan, door, shower, pantry, bed, family.

There are many people in Australia who do not have a safe, comfortable home to live in.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 tells us that there is a season for everything and a “time for every activity under Heaven”. This week is Homelessness Week, and the theme for The Salvation Army is, “It’s time to end homelessness: together, we can.”

God wants us to love and respect every person and to do what we can to help others.

Isaiah 1:17 reminds us to, “Say no to wrong. Learn to do good. Work for justice. Help the down-and-out. Stand up for the homeless. Go to bat for the defenseless.”

Finding safe homes for every person in Australia might seem like a big job but here are two things you could do to help:

- Always treat people with kindness, love and respect
- Write a letter to the government asking them to help those who do not have a safe home
