


International Day for the

Leaders notes

PPT 1

The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women is the annual launch of 16 days of activism, from 25 November to 10 December. The date 25 November commemorates the deaths of the three Mirabal sisters, women who spoke up about the corrupt and abusive behaviour of the President of the Dominican Republic. They were killed in 1960 by order of the President.

PPT 2

PPT 3

At (Corps name), we value women for the contribution they make to our corps, and to our community.

PPT 4

However, when we look at the statistics, the chances are that women we know and love have experienced violence at some point in their lives.

PPT 5

1 in 3 women have experienced physical or sexual violence, or both, perpetrated by a man they know.

PPT 6

Almost 10 women a day are hospitalised for assault injuries perpetrated by a spouse or domestic partner.

PPT 7

At (Corps name), we commit to doing all we can to ensure that this does not continue.

PPT 8

Each year, The Salvation Army, Australia assists **more than 7,000 women and children experiencing family and domestic violence**. Our services focus on prevention, restoration and healing, providing specialist family and domestic violence support to families and individuals who are experiencing and recovering from violence and/or modern slavery and forced marriage.
