

Need to do:

- Record the following details on the plastic bag:
 - Value of coins
 - Date of lodgement
 - Record Account Name in 'Packed By' box; and
 - Record Depositor Name in 'Sealed By' box
- Complete your NAB deposit slip. You can deposit multiple coin safe bags using one deposit slip. The total amount (of all bags) will show on the bank statement.
- Deposit the money at your local NAB Branch over the counter (**Bulk Coin Bags cannot be deposited at Aus Post Outlets**).
- Log one "banking receipt" on the web app (volunteer.salvos.org.au) for the entire deposit (multiple bags).

Accessing bulk coin bags

- Bulk Coin Bags to be requested by emailing Banking Enquiries bankingenquiries@salvationarmy.org.au. Corps can use old Coin Safe bags. These are generic and can be used across different banking providers.

Bulk coin bags allows for large amounts of a single coin denomination to be banked in one bag. Bulk coin bags can only be used at NAB branches; **this service is not available at Australia Post**.

The bag must contain the **exact value for that coin denomination** as listed below:

- \$2 coins- value \$2000
- \$1 coins- value \$500
- 50c coins- value \$200
- 20c coins- value \$100
- 10c coins- value \$100
- 5c coins- values \$100
