We think of the families who have lost loved ones, or have family members who are injured, sick or in danger. Families in mourning, families divided by conflict. We pray you will bring them comfort and safety.

May they know your peace and comfort today. May they experience your love. Restore those who are sick or have been injured.

We think of the people who have lost their homes in areas of conflict, people who are seeking refuge. We pray for those who must move from the place they have lived in their whole lives.

May they find refuge, and a stable place to live, work and raise their children.
