The Red Shield Appeal is The Salvation Army's signature fundraising drive, and helps fund our vast network of social and community services.

Each year, The Salvation Army appeals to the Australian community for support to ensure we can continue to give hope where it's needed most. This is achieved through our social welfare and community service programs, including homelessness services, family welfare assistance, youth drop-in centres and support programs, drug and alcohol rehabilitation services and employment services.

The Red Shield Appeal is an annual campaign particularly emphasised in May, however activities in support of the Appeal can take place at any point throughout the year. Many collections and events take place on the last weekend in May — known as the Red Shield Appeal Doorknock weekend.

- Tangible activities to support curriculum objectives
