Educational workshops – Secondary school

► Leaders of Change (Years 7-12)

Develop students' leadership, teamwork and project-planning skills as they investigate some of Australia's most pressing social issues and deliver a project that makes a meaningful impact in their local community.

► Homelessness (Years 7-12)

Investigate the realities, causes and impacts of homelessness in Australia. Students will see beyond common misconceptions and discover how we can all play a part in ending homelessness.

► James' Story (Years 7-8)

Learn about the experiences of financial hardship in Australia. Students will learn about the practical support and services provided by The Salvation Army and how the Salvos offer people hope and a pathway forward.

► Financial Hardship (Years 9-12)

Explores the concept and complexities of financial hardship in Australia through an interactive life simulation, deepening understanding of the varied circumstances that can impact financial wellbeing.

► Take Action with the Salvos (Years 7-8)

Discover the work of The Salvation Army and be inspired to take action by participating in a school initiative like assembling care packs, hosting a fundraiser or running a donation drive.

► Homelessness City Tour (Years 9-12)

Step beyond the classroom and into an immersive city experience that brings the realities of homelessness to life. Students will hear real-world stories, learn about the support services provided by The Salvation Army and be inspired to act for justice.
