## AUTOGRAPH BINGO

### WORKS BEST

Any number of people. Indoors.

### NEEDS

A personalised bingo card for each person  
Make a bingo card of statements, such as has blue eyes, has lived in another state, has more pets than siblings ect.

Pens for each person  
Print out enough copies for each member to have their own. Make them generic things unless you know obscure facts about your youth.

## THE GAME

Each person gets a card and a pen, they must then go around and find people who find each statement true for themselves. They then get that person to sign or write their name in that box. The first person with all boxes correctly filled is the winner. You must not use the same person twice. To prevent this you may want to make the bingo card smaller in comparison to the size of your group.

If someone gets asked something and it is true for them they must sign. Players can not avoid signing in attempts to win the game.

### NOTES

One of the best things about these games is that they encourage teamwork and interaction, so they're great icebreaker and relationship-building games.
