DOG AND THE BONE

WORKS BEST

Indoors.

NEEDS

Any object that resembles a dog bone.

THE GAME

The children sit in a circle. One child sits in the middle with his eyes shut and a bone behind him. A person in charge points to one of the children in the circle. That child has to creep in and get the bone and put it behind his back.

All children put their hands behind their back and say "Doggie, doggie, who's got the bone?" The dog then opens his eyes and has to try to choose who has his bone. He has two guesses. If he guesses correctly he has another turn. If he doesn't the child with the bone is the new dog. The game then starts again.
